

CHILDREN'S PROGRAM

The Spiritual Education of Children Program is a spiritual and intellectual education program taught by trained volunteers designed for children ages 4-10 of all faiths and denominations (activities for youth and adults are also available, all at no cost). The mission of the program is to establish a strong spiritual foundation within each child.

The program is offered through weekly children's classes often held in your neighborhood. The classes usually last an hour to an hour-and-a-half, and include songs with positive messages, spiritually empowering prayers and quotations, virtue stories and concepts, cooperative games, and arts and crafts.

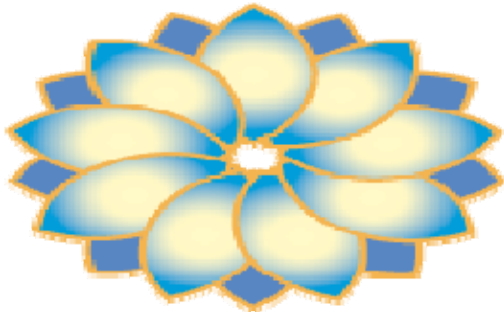

“We are witnessing high and rising rates of depression, anxiety, attention deficit, conduct disorders, thoughts of suicide, and other serious mental, emotional, and behavioural problems among U.S children and adolescents.

In large measure, what’s causing this crisis of American childhood is a lack of connectedness. We mean two kinds of connectedness—close connections to other people, and deep connections to moral and spiritual meaning.” —Hardwired to Connect: A report by the Institute of American Values, the YMCA of the USA, and Dartmouth Medical School.



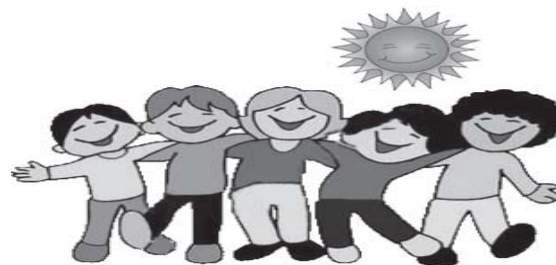

The Bahá'í Faith Community is a worldwide community whose purpose is to unite all the races and religions of the world. Bahá'ís believe that there is only one God, who created us all in order to know and love Him. Bahá'ís believe that the great religions of the world teach the same truth, primarily, the “Golden Rule,” and that the only difference between them are that they appeared at a different time in the history of humanity, to educate people according to the needs and conditions of that time.
